7 TIPS FOR PREVENTING FROZEN PIPES DURING WINTER BUILDING CLOSURES



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KEEP THE FURNACE RUNNING AND BUILDING HEATED EVEN WHEN IT'S EMPTY.

ENSURE BUILDING TEMPERATURES ARE KEPT ABOVE 55 DEGREES.

CONSIDER INSTALLING A GENERATOR TO KEEP THE PROPERTY HEATED IN THE EVENT OF A POWER OUTAGE.

HAVE THE FURNACE/HEATING SYSTEM INSPECTED AND MAINTAINED REGULARLY.

PRIOR TO CLOSING FOR A BREAK, ENSURE THERE'S NO UNADDRESSED PROPERTY DAMAGE THAT COULD LEAD TO COLD AIR GETTING INTO THE BUILDING.

HAVE MAINTENANCE OR OTHER STAFF MEMBERS CHECK ON THE BUILDING REGULARLY DURING THE CLOSURE.

CONSULT YOUR ALARM COMPANY REGARDING THE ADDITION OF TEMPERATURE SENSORS. THESE SENSORS WILL DETECT IF TEMPERATURES IN YOUR BUILDING FALL BELOW A PREDETERMINED LEVEL.
